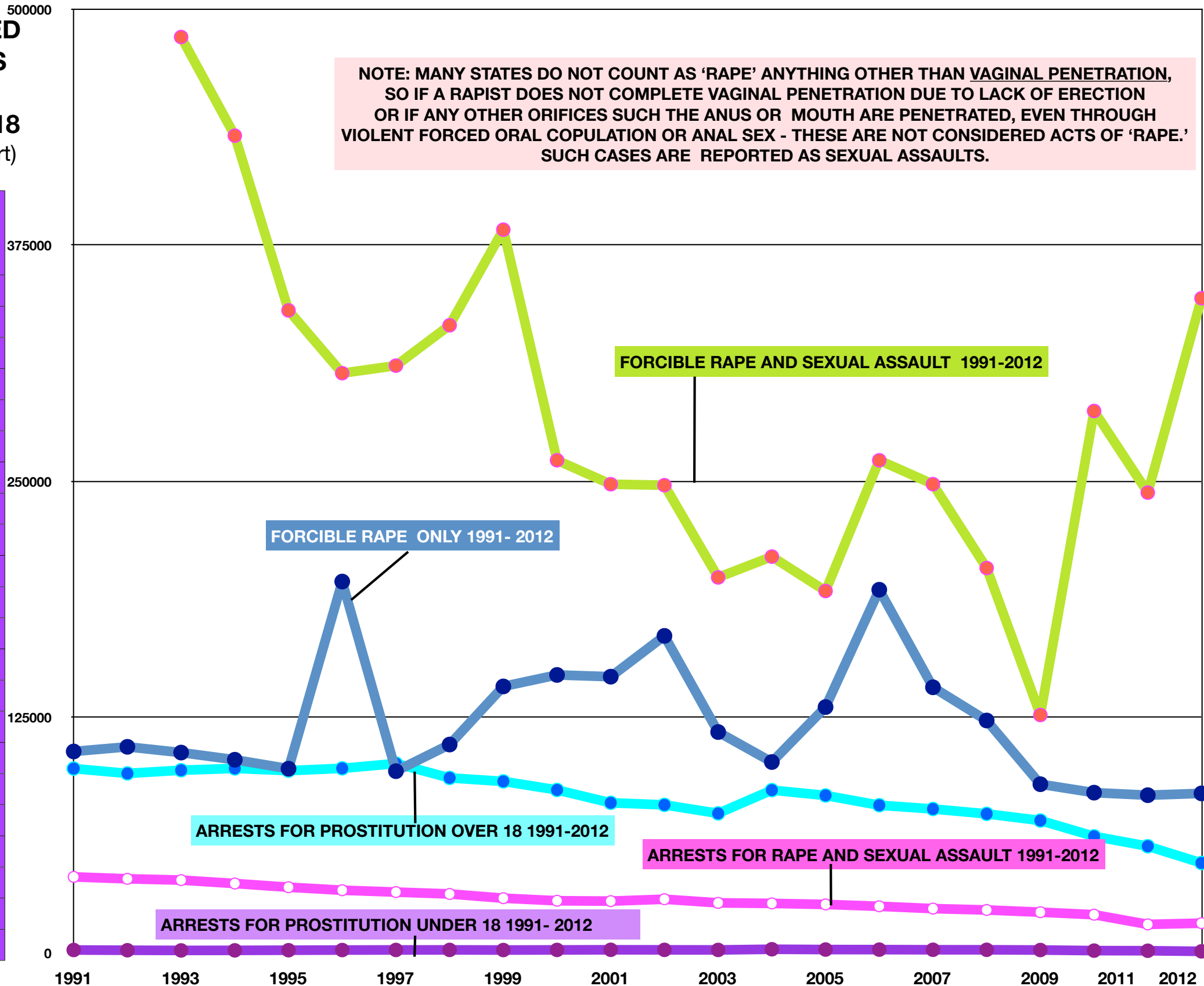
Number of unsolved rape cases 1991-2012= 5,049,220

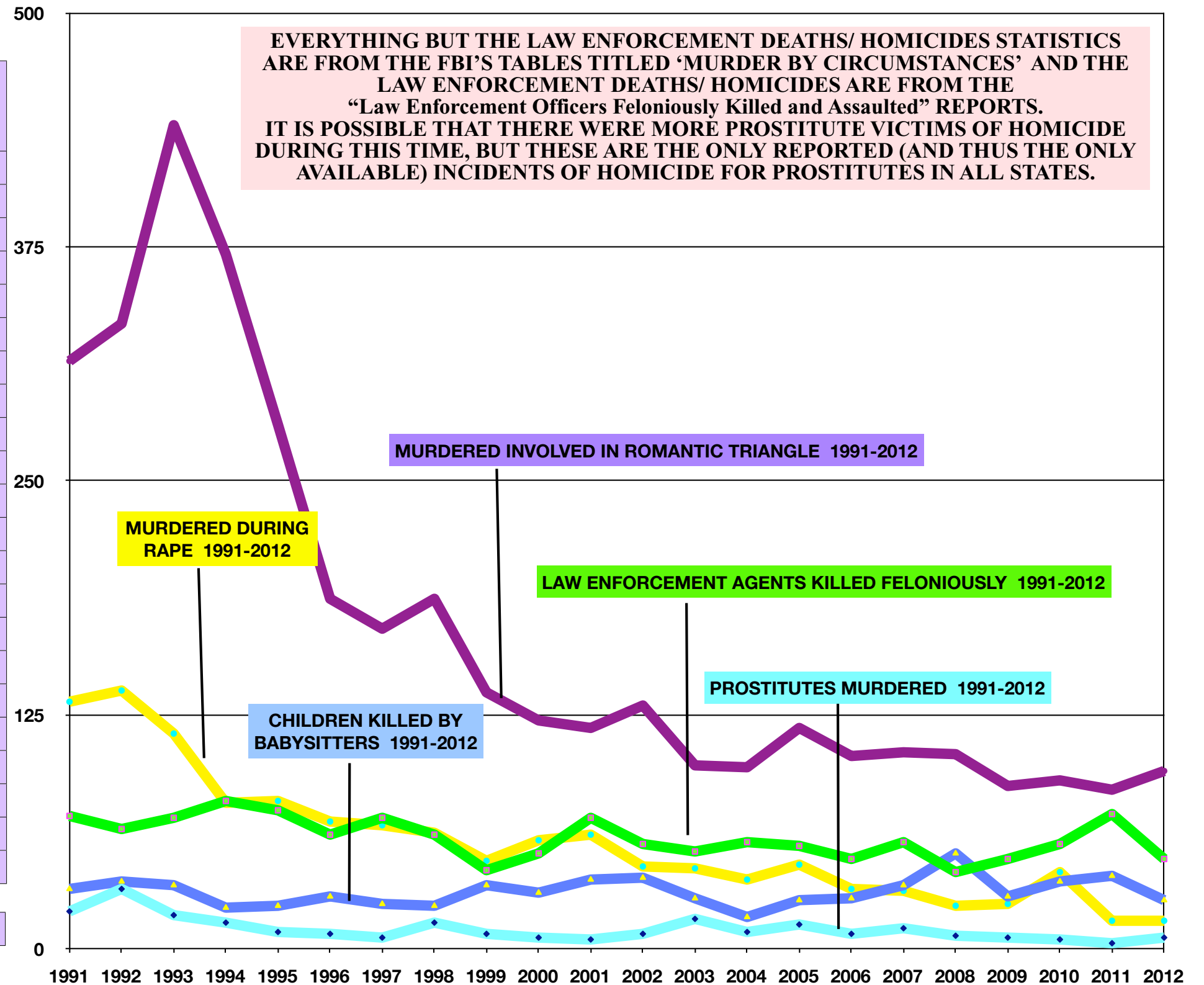

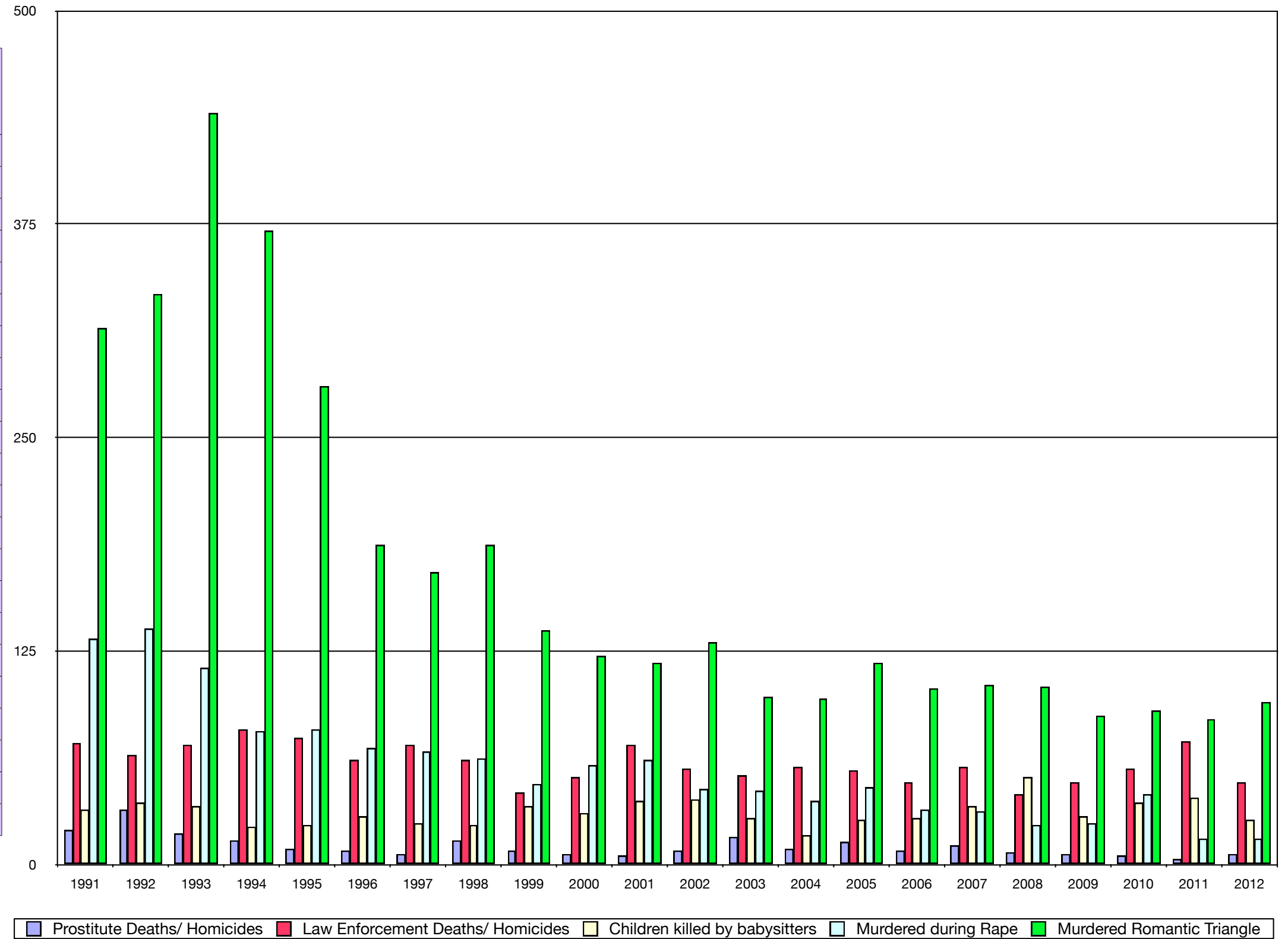
