Violence against women by the numbers:

For **intimate partner violence**, the type of violence against women for which more data were available, the worst affected regions were: (From the WHO report 2013)

- 1 South-East Asia 37.7% prevalence. Based on aggregated data from Bangladesh, Timor-Leste (East Timor), India, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, Thailand.
- 2 Eastern Mediterranean 37% prevalence. Based on aggregated data from Egypt, Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Palestine.
- 3 Africa 36.6% prevalence. Based on aggregated data from Botswana, Cameroon, Democratic Republic of Congo, Ethiopia, Kenya, Lesotho, Liberia, Malawi, Mozambique, Namibia, Rwanda, South Africa, Swaziland, Uganda, United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Zimbabwe.
- 4 The Americas followed with 29.8%

For combined intimate partner and non-partner sexual violence or both among all women of 15 years or older, prevalence rates were as follows:

- 1 Africa 45.6%
- 2 Americas 36.1% (for purposes of this document, we used the 33% estimate rather than the higher one)
- 3 Eastern Mediterranean -36.4%* (No data were available for non-partner sexual violence in this region)
- 4 Europe 27.2%
- 5 South-East Asia 40.2%
- 6 Western Pacific 27.9%
- 7 High income countries -32.7%

In the USA: Potential victims of domestic violence:

64.9 million number of married women 18 and older in 2011.
