## Former Middlesex Township Pennsylvania Police Officer Kenny Johnson, Sentenced To County Prison For Bribery And Promoting Prostitution, Gets A Continuance Instead Of Going To Jail Over Holidays

**2006-12-19 MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, PENNSYLVANIA** - A former Middlesex Township police officer has avoided jail at least until the holidays are over.

**Kenny Johnson**, who was sentenced in April 2005 to serve 9 to 23 months in Cumberland County Prison, was given a continuance today until Jan. 2 because he still has time to file an appeal with the state Supreme Court.

Johnson was convicted of bribery and promoting prostitution after a four-day trial in March 2005 for soliciting sex from an undercover officer. Police organized the sting after hearing that Johnson accepted sex from suspected prostitutes on the township's Miracle Mile instead of arresting them.

Johnson appealed to the state Superior Court, but that court upheld the conviction. He is free on \$10,000 bail pending his appeals.
