

Next, let's review the numbers of female arrests for *disorderly conduct over 32 years from 1981 to 2012:

FEMALE ARRESTS DISORDERLY CONDUCT OVER A 30 YEAR PERIOD 1981- 2012: (*not all arrests for D.C. were *instead of a* prostitution arrest, but we suspect that many of them are, particularly where the prostitution laws are not as vague as they are in California and it takes more effort to prove a 'solicitation' or 'intent to commit' prostitution)

- Female arrests disorderly conduct all 1981- 2012: 4,828,643
- of this number, **1,309,448** were under 18 **27.12%**
- and **3,519,197** were over 18 **72.88%**
- **Of those under 18, numbers are:**
 - age 17: **236,300**
 - age 16: **270,295**
 - age 15: **283,678**
 - age 13-14: **401,44**
 - age 10-12: **107,480**
 - age under 10: **10,244**
- **Of those over 18, the majority were ages 25+ :2,918,587 (60.44%)**
 - age 18- 20: **600,617**
 - ages 21 to 24: **734,589**
 - ages 25- 29: **665,691**
 - age 30- 65+ were: **1,518,307**

Still have a majority of female arrests for disorderly conduct over age 25...
We do not have any way to know how many of these arrests were *instead* of prostitution solicitation. Nevertheless we can conclude that the statement that the “average age of entry into prostitution is 12/ 13/14”
IS NOT TRUE!
